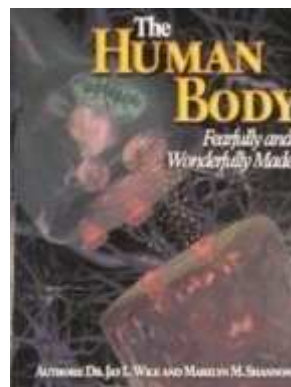

Description: This is an advanced biology course. To take this course, the student **MUST** have completed a first-year biology course. It covers both the anatomy and the physiology of the human body's 11 organ systems in detail. The reproductive system will be covered in this course. Depending on parent/student preference, reproduction will be covered with the male and female students learning separately, or it will be the responsibility of the parents to teach this information to their students.

Additional Class Fees (if any): Lab Fee \$50

Required Supplies: Text (\$45-65), coloring book (\$15-\$25), colored pencils

Prerequisites: Completion of Biology preferably with at least a B

Homework Requirements: Students will read about 20 pages in the text on a weekly basis. Other homework will include weekly study guides (about 15 questions), coloring book assignments, pre-lab write-ups, and a project due the 1st semester. Assignments will take 4-5 hours per week to complete. Bi-weekly quizzes will be given in class, and there will be Quarterly Tests.

Additional Course Information: All grading will be done by the tutor. Study guides will be reviewed during the class time. This is an upper level science course, therefore all students will be required to complete the assignments and will receive a grade for high school credit. There is not an option to audit this course.
