

Course Title: **Mystery of History Volume 2 (MOH)**

Level: **Middle School**

Description: The book describes this course as follows: “*The Mystery of History Volume II* (MOH vol. 2) provides a historically accurate, Bible-centered approach to learning the history of the early church through the Middle Ages. The completely chronological lessons span the continents to shed new light on who walked the earth when and how God revealed Himself to mankind during this pivotal period of history...From the incarnation of Jesus Christ to the spread of the Gospel across the globe, the Lord beckons and calls us to know Him. Some men bow down to Him; some men don't. But God's purpose remains the same. Whether it is the stories of kings and queens, emperors and samurai, knights and inventors, or poets and commoners, the epic continues to unfold in *The Mystery of History Volume 2.*”

In class, we will

- complete memory cards as we review the lessons the students have read for homework
- make timelines
- take quizzes
- play review games

Text required is *The Mystery of History Volume II The Early Church and the Middle Ages* by Linda Lacour Hobar.

Students will also need a Bible and internet access.

Points will be awarded for homework, quizzes, timelines, etc., but parents will assign actual grades.

In addition, there will also be certain weeks when map work and studying for quizzes will be assigned. Opportunities to earn extra credit will also be given. Homework is **NOT OPTIONAL** and **IS REQUIRED** for classroom participation. Students will read lessons from the MOH vol. 2 book, will use a Bible, and must have access to the internet or library. Homework should take 30 minutes to 1 hour or longer per day.

**Additional Course Information:** Those who took MOH vol. 1 with me will be pleased to know I will not require you to take your books apart this year! I will be writing my own quizzes and tests, so it will not be necessary to rip them out of the book.
